USSA Membership Registration Guide



Introduction

From the why to the how. This article will cover everything that you need to know to register your athlete for a USSA membership.

Why do I Need a USSA Membership?

The Crotched Mountain Freestyle Team competes in multiple freestyle events throughout the season. These events are sanctioned by the US Ski and Snowboard Association or USSA. To register your athlete to compete in these events a valid USSA membership is required. These memberships are seasonal and will need to be renewed yearly. The membership will be good from July 1st to June 30th of the following year. Please note that it does not matter what time of the year you register. All memberships will expire on June 30th each year. USSA events are offered across all ages starting with our young rippers competing in small regional events from the ages of 7 to 13. To our older athletes competing in divisional events from the ages of 14 and up. USSA events go all the way up to the national level where athletes can compete in the US Nationals and JR Nationals events as they try to make their way onto the World Cup Series!!!

What is the Cost of a USSA Membership?

The cost to register for a USSA Membership is as follows.

2022-23 USSA registration costs

Freestyle Competitor U11 & Under (10 & under) - \$75 + \$50 Eastern division fee

Freestyle Competitor U13 (11-12) - \$110 + \$50 Eastern division fee

Freestyle Competitor U15 & Up (13 & over) - \$200 + \$50 Eastern division fee

Freestyle Short Term All ages \$35 per day NO EASTERN DIVISION FEE (**This membership is only good for a single event. To register for a second, you will need to buy the full membership**)

The cost of this membership helps to support the US Ski and Snowboard Association. This includes costs of organizing and structuring ski and snowboard events across the county and throughout all of the major ski and snowboard disciplines. As well as helping to support the US Ski and Snowboard Teams! The US Ski and Snowboard Foundation is a non-profit organization that plays a major role in funding our Winter Olympic Athletes. What do I Get with my USSA Membership?

Along with receiving your USSA membership card that will allow you to register your athlete for events throughout the season. You will receive a copy of the rule book that governs all our east coast freestyle events. This rule book has tons of great information on freestyle competitions and is well worth reading through even though it may be a little difficult for first time competitors. You should also receive some awesome USSA stickers so that you can let everyone know that you are a supporter of the US Ski and Snowboard teams!

How do I Register for a USSA Membership?

To register your athlete for a membership just follow the steps below!


Step 1.

Visit the USSA website at <https://my.us skiandsnowboard.org/myussa>

Step 2.

First, you will need to create an account with USSA. The account is free! Make sure that you create this account with YOUR NAME and NOT your athletes. This will ensure that your account is created accurately and is easy to access. You will be able to input your athlete's information when applying for the membership.

Click on the "CREATE AN ACCOUNT" button.

This will take you to the "Create an Account" page. Enter your information, choose a username and password, and create your account. Under the section "What are you interested in?" you can choose any or all of the disciplines, but we recommend at least selecting "Freestyle" as this is the discipline that your athlete will be competing in.



Step 4.

Once you have finished creating your account you will be able to log in and you will be directed to the "My USSA Dashboard". This dashboard will be your home base for all of your USSA needs, with the exception of event registration. Registering for events will done through the Eastern Freestyle website. They are a branch of USSA and operate all the freestyle specific events on the East Coast. Please check out our article on event registration if that is what you are looking for. When you log into your account you should have a dashboard that looks like the image below. Click on the option "Register a new USSA member".

In the "My Account" box on your [My USSA](#) page click the link "Register a new USSA member". You will be redirected to the online Membership application. You can register a new USSA membership for yourself or for someone else (i.e. a parent who needs to register a new USSA membership for their kid).





Step 10.

Next from the "Membership" drop down menu select "Freestyle Competitor" the U-age will automatically update based on your athlete's birth year. **Make sure to use FREESTYLE. If you do not have the correct discipline, you will not be able to register for the events.** Freestyle covers both USSA Slopestyle and Moguls. When both "Sport" and "Membership" are selected make sure to click the button and add your membership to the cart.



Step 12.

Once you have confirmed your choice of membership you will be taken through a few pages of various offers from USSA. Your first offer will be a chance to purchase your self some US Ski Team Apparel. The second offer will be for Global Rescue. This would cover your athlete in a case of emergency where they needed to be flight evacuated from the mountain to a hospital. This would be considered additional coverage on top of your own medical insurance policy. It is highly unlikely that your athlete will need it but the offer is there if you wish to take it.

Bonus Packs and Decals

This season offers both men's and women's bonus packs which include a high quality soft style ring spun poly/cotton blend shirt. T-shirts are available in adult sizes only. Both men's and women's sizes are available in small through extra-large. The U.S. Ski Team and U.S. logo packs include a decal strip and a 2023 collectors pin. The U.S. Snowboard and U.S. Freeski packs include a sport decal strip and US die-cut decal. Packs are \$28 each (includes shipping). **Each pack is shipped separately.**

Step 13.



Congratulations on your USSA Membership

Now that you have registered for your membership you will receive a USSA ID number. This number will be unique to your athlete and will remain theirs for life, even after they have finished competing. Fun fact, 13 years after the last time I competed I am still able to access my USSA account and look back at the scores from every event I have ever participated in. You will need your athletes USSA ID to register them for the USSA sanctioned events this winter. Their ID number will be listed out on their membership card. You will be able to access it electronically through your "My USSA Dashboard" and you will also be sent a physical copy of the card in the mail. When you return to your account dashboard you should have your athlete's name listed next to yours, in the linked members area. If you click on their icon, you will be able to see their USSA ID, Membership Status, and you will also have the option to print their Member Card. A preferred method for accessing your Membership ID is to take a photo of the card with your phone and save that photo in it's own album in your photo gallery. This ensures that you always have the ID Number handy when you need it! Once again congratulations on becoming a USSA member and we can't wait to see you at some events this winter!
